Thank you for your interest in serving with us here at King of Kings Community Jerusalem. Before submitting your application, we ask that you would read the information below and prayerfully consider the practical logistics of living and serving in Israel. I. Living in Israel Prior to applying to volunteer at King of Kings, here are a few points that you will want to prayerfully consider.

Expenses

The totals below are based on approximations and are subject to the current exchange rate. Personal spending money should be considered in addition.

Housing

Volunteers should plan on finding their own housing once in Jerusalem, however, King of Kings will do their best to assist accepted applicants to locate modest housing on a rental basis. Early application submission is advised to provide the time needed to plan for housing.

Support

Everyone on the King of Kings team is responsible for raising his or her own financial support. For this reason, all costs associated with your travel, health and stay are your own responsibility. There are no scholarships available.

Health Insurance

Each applicant must provide his or her own health insurance coverage. King of Kings will not be able to cover hospitalization and/or visits to the doctor. Ask your travel agent about travel insurance that will fully cover you while you are here. If you are applying to volunteer with us for a long term period (2+ years), you can opt for purchasing health insurance in Israel. If you require prescription medication (or even non-prescription) we recommend you bring a sufficient supply to cover the length of your stay.

II. Visa Process

Generally, three month entry tourist visas are given without charge to US, EU, UK, Ireland, New Zealand, Australia and Canadian citizens without prior application when they enter Israel and show passports that are valid for at least 9 months beyond the time of arrival. If you live in another country, please check the regulations for entry into Israel. Volunteer visas (maximum time allowed by the Ministry of Interior is 2 years) are applied for in Israel by King of Kings, the process takes 6 to 8 weeks. Once the visa is approved, it will be sent to your local Israeli embassy. You need to contact your embassy in order to pick it up. Applicants can not be in Israel during this process.

III. Application Process We will review your application once we have received your application in full, this includes the following:

- Application Form
- Photograph
- 1 or 2 page typed personal testimony
- Pastoral reference form – in a sealed envelope, signed by the individual
- Personal reference form- in a sealed envelope, signed by the individual
- Interview (via phone or Skype) after the above forms are received
